<u>Malta</u>

Sunday 2ND April 2017: Flight from Brussels to Malta on KM421 departing Brussels at 19:50.

Arriving in Malta at 22.25

 Friday 7th April 2017: Flight from Malta to Brussels on KM420 departing Brussels at 15:50.

Arriving in Brussels at 19:00

The Carlton Plaza Hotel, Sliema. 4 bedded studio apartments with bathroom en suite.

Continental breakfast every morning at the hotel.

Packed lunch during the week when we have activities and also on Friday (departure day) before the transfer to the airport.

Dinner shall be in restaurant of the hotel.

Full board, flights, transport, visits - total cost 700 euros

Monday-Day 1:

Morning: Orientation walk on the first day (around your accommodation area), and information about the Islands including general history, demographics, etc

Afternoon: Outing to the South of the island visiting Marsaxlokk, Wied iz-Zurrieq .

(Possibility of a boat trip depending on the weather)

Visit to a wine vineyard (Meridiana or Marsovin)

• Tuesday-Day 2:

Morning: in Valletta including a visit to the Malta Experience (ticket included)

Afternoon: in the 3 Cities, Cottonera its historical buildings, museums, etc

Also possible boat trips in the Blue Grotto Caves, in Zurrieq, weather permitting

• Wednesday-Day 3:

FD (Full Day) visiting Gozo.

Price includes ticket for crossing to the other island by ferry, private transport all day included in Gozo and meals.

Visiting Ggantija, Temples dating back to 3600-2500BC, Wine & cheese-making farm/vineyard, The Citadel in the Capital City of Gozo, and the Azure Window in Dwejra.

• Thursday – Day 4:

1 hour at the **Ta' Qali Crafts Village** where we can see the local glass blowing trade. Also included are pottery factories and the production of another typical Maltese trade, silver filigree

Then on to Mdina and Rabat where we shall visit :

- a) Catacombs of St.Paul, where he lived for 3 months after being shipwrecked in 60AD.
- b) The Roman Villa.
- c) The Cathedral Of St.Paul.
- d) The Historical Bastions of Mdina.
- e) The co-Cathedral of Mdina

On to Ghadira Bay in the afternoon where we shall have time for swimming (and OPTIONAL water sports - not included in the price). A lifeguard will be present.

• Friday – Day 5:

Free time after breakfast and packing, then on to airport at 1.30pm for flight back to Brussels at 4pm.

• Other:

•The group will also have the following activities fitted in the programme:

- 1.Free-time for shopping in Valletta, Gozo, etc
- 2. Also on the last day where I shall accompany whoever would like to join to a shopping mall.
- 3.Evening outings to Paceville where students can join the group at Karaoke/Bowling/ etc but can also go to the cinema, games areas etc.
- 4.Sometimes students <u>will not be accompanied</u> but it is a very strict rule that entry in Bars/Clubs/ Discos is STRICTLY OFF LIMITS. The minimum age is 18 and unlawful entry and underage drinking are punishable by Law under the Maltese Constitution.
- 5.Students who do not respect this need not apply for this trip as they WILL be sent back to Belgium if this rule is broken.
