The test result of the minor child will be communicated to the parents or legal guardian. The nurses will encode the result in the Belgian system so that the parents and pupils can have the QR code. In case of a positive result, parents are asked to inform the APEEE services or other third parties. In case both parents have parental authority, the form can be signed by one of them, the parent signing guarantees that the second parent also consents to the test being performed on his/her child.

Information on the processing of personal data:

Within the framework of this system, three data processing operations are implemented, the characteristics of which are described below.

1. The data strictly necessary for the organization of screening tests within the school (last name, first name and class of the student, consent of his legal guardians (Y/N)) are processed under the responsibility of the head of the school for the performance of a mission of public interest within the meaning of e) of Article 6 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
2. The form containing the parental authorization will be kept in the student's medical file to prevent disputes or complaints, in accordance with Article 9(2)(f) of the European Data Protection Regulation. The medical file is kept and managed exclusively by the infirmary, in accordance with the criteria set out in the European School's Privacy Statement, available via the school's website.
3. Handling of the result:

The test result will not be kept by the school, but consulted by the infirmary service, which must communicate the result to federal services for the generation of the QR code. This is why we need your child's NISS.

In the case of a positive result: the processing of the information of your result that you transmit to the infirmary is justified for purposes of preventive medicine and to control the propagation of the coronavirus in its mission of tracing control assimilated to that of the services of Health Promotion at the School (PSE). The information is not kept longer than the time necessary to control clusters and quarantines and will be communicated to unauthorized third parties.

This processing of health-related data is an exception to the prohibition in Article 9 of the GDPR.

Medical personnel have the right, as stated in Article 9.2.h of the GDPR, to access this information for the purposes of preventive medicine and the provision of health care.
