



Constraints - to remember....

• Selected courses = for **2 years** S4 + S5

- Choose at least 4 periods of optional materials
- Do not exceed a maximum of 35 periods in total.
- History, geography, economics, religion/moral => given in L2(De, EN or FR).



Constraints to remember...

- Sports classes, art, music, ICT: mixed language groups (DE, EN, FR)
- Minimum number of students to open a course: 7 pupils.
 - Afraid a class might not be open? > Specify "a at the bottom of the ENROLMENT FORM. replacement option
 - Courses indicated on ENROLMENT FORM= not guaranteed: this depends on the number of students and available teachers (idem at the end of S5 for S6).
- **NB: Combinations excluded**: they are taught at the same time on the timetable:

-L4 + Ancient Greek/ONL

-Economics + Latin

- Latin only possible in S4 if followed in S3.
- Chinese: available only from S6.





Rules and constraints



«Consistent choice between : S4/S5 => S6/S7»

A) Consistent choice of periods of maths:

• maths 4 per in S4/S5 => maths <u>3per</u> in S6/S7.

• maths 6 per in S4/S5 = maths 5 per in S6/S7 + possibility maths 8

B) Scientific profile (including the choice of Physics) in S6? : requires maths 5 per, so choose maths 6 periods in S4.

C) Economics in S6/S7? (for studies of economics at the university): this class requires maths 5 in S6, so choose maths 6 periods in S4s5.



Rules and constraints

Adaptations S4/S5 => S6/S7:

 YOU NEED TO SIT AN LEVEL/ENTRENCE TEST AT THE END OF s5 IF:

- Maths 4per in s4/s5 and would like to choose maths 5per in S6
- <u>Start a course in s6, not chosen in s4/s5</u>: E.g.Art, Music, Economics, Latin, Ancient Greek, ICT, or a new language?
- It is advisable to take a course in s4/s5 if you plan to follow that course all the way to your Baccalaureate (s6/s7)
- **Change the level of your language course** (e.g. go from L4 to L3)






- Total of 27 or 29 periods (according to Math 4 or 6)

- Maximum 35 periods






