1. thinking before I share
 - I think carefully about what I share and who I share it with

2. spotting the scams

 - I remind myself there is a real person behind the screen (e.g. how will my message make someone feel?)
 - I remain polite and positive (e.g. is this something I would say in real life?)
 - I take a break and talk it out in person in conflict situations
 - I push back against hate, discrimination and prejudice of all kinds (racism, xenophobia, homophobia, etc.) and harassment and report it to an adult
5. speaking out
 - I do not consent to situations that make me feel uncomfortable
 - I defend victims of malicious or inappropriate behavior online I am the witness of
 - I immediately talk to an adult when in doubt, worried or offended by an online behavior or a suspicious activity
