Candidates must meet the following conditions:

- Command of the above language equivalent to that of an educated native speaker
- Appropriate diploma: diploma working with students with special needs in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Education.
- Recent experience in secondary education
- Proven experience of excellent teaching practices and teamwork
- Experience of teaching (in class and in one-to-one course) for student with special need
- Ability to teach using effective differentiation
- A high level of professionalism and attention to student welfare
- Willingness to contribute to the life of the secondary school

Preference will be given to a teacher who:

- has teaching experience in a European or international school
- has experience in educational support and school inclusion
- incorporates new technologies as a teaching tool
- undertakes to teach from the lower secondary cycle to the baccalaureate cycle
- has fluency in another European language
