JOB DESCRIPTION AND MAIN TASKS

Under the hierarchical authority of the Deputy Director of the Secondary Cycle and Deputy Director of Finance and Administration, in Uccle, the science lab technician is responsible for managing teaching materials and organising and preparing demonstrations and practical work for science lessons. Their skills must be focused on biology.

The science lab technician for biology is entrusted with the following tasks:

MANAGEMENT

- Proposal for the purchase of new equipment that has an educational interest in relation to the programs, that allows increased security, or that benefits from the latest technologies;
- Accounting management of annual budgets (supplies and teaching materials);
- Purchase of teaching supplies and materials in collaboration with the subject coordinator;
- Contact with suppliers and requests for price quotations;
- Drafting of ordering proposals;
- Order tracking;
- Reception, unpacking and storage of equipment;
- Management and maintenance of the devices, teaching materials, and products used;
- Storage, management, and disposal of chemicals and materials in accordance with regulations;
- Updating inventories of laboratory equipment and products.

ORGANISATION

- Organization and maintenance of laboratories;
- Provision of the necessary devices, apparatus and products during practical and theoretical teaching, taking care to maximize safety;
- Provision of personal protective equipment if necessary;
- Proposal to teachers of pre-established practical work in relation to the educational programs that is achievable with the equipment and chemicals available;
- Development of new experiments in collaboration with teachers;
- Adaptation of existing protocols following the launch of new course programs.

OTHER TASKS

- Assistance to teachers for computerized practical work or additional courses;
- Allocation of science classrooms based on teachers' timetables and class sizes provided by schedulers;
- Follow-up of changes to teachers' timetables in collaboration with the group of science lab technicians;
- Any other occasional task useful to the service when the Deputy Director deems it necessary and appropriate.

REQUIRED PROFILE

- At least a master's degree in biology;
- Experience of at least 2 years in the organization and operation of a laboratory;
- Experience as a science lab technician in a school is an asset;
- A very good command of computer tools (MS Office) and an ability to quickly master new software;
- Organizational flexibility, proactivity and a sense of independence;
- Excellent interpersonal skills;
- A spirit of collaboration with the teachers, the subject coordinator and the other science lab technicians;
- Compliance with internal procedures, instructions and standards in force (particularly in terms of security);
- An excellent command of French and good knowledge of English; any other European language is an asset.
