Please help your child to look after all their property by ensuring all clothes, coats, boots, shoes, bottles, snack boxes etc. are clearly labeled with a permanent marker with their name and class, MatEn. This will increase the possibility of them being returned from the 'Lost and Found' office if it gets to that extreme stage.

Please help your child to hang coats, jumpers etc., on pegs by having a sewn in 'hook' in them so avoiding everything ending up on the floor. Using the hood makes them too long for the coat rack.

Sports outfit/Tenue de sport

According to the provisions of the general rules of the European schools, it is mandatory for the pupils of primary to wear the official sports outfit of the school during the physical education and swimming lessons.

For PRIMARY pupils the outfit consists of a blue T-shirt and shorts (with or without your child's name) and a swim cap.

For NURSERY pupils, the sports outfit is recommended but not mandatory.
